
2. Without prejudice to the overall responsibility of acting as a 'Friend, Philosopher and Guide' of CAPART with regard to improvement in the transparency & accountability in the organization as per the spirit of the RTI Act, 2005, the Transparency Committee will be specifically responsible for the following :-

- > It will examine in detail the extant position of disclosures in CAPART so as to assure that it is sufficient to meet the mandatory requirement of Section 4 (l) a) & b) of the RTI Act. It shall also indicate scope for further improvement so as to ensure the compliance in letter and spirit.
- > It will suggest ways & means and areas where voluntary disclosure can be enhanced by CAPART.
- > It will deliberate and suggest institutional arrangements by which CAPART can facilitate the voluntary organizations working with CAPART to improve the transparency and accountability as per the spirit of the RTI Act.

3. The Committee shall meet as often as required but not less than once in a quarter.

4. SM(ITD) & CPIO of CAPART will also remain present during the meetings in addition to those specifically required by the Chairperson to assist the Committee.

5. The members of the Committee will be paid TA/DA as per the norms for the EC/GB members.
