CIRCULAR No.03/2011

Subject: Release of backlog grant-in-aid for the ongoing projects by NGOs.

On 24th August, 2009 in the 49th meeting of the Executive Committee, while discussing the Performance Report of CAPART, it was decided that no further project funds will be disbursed by the RCs until the matter is reviewed by a sub-committee with regard to time overrun, if any, and in case of time overrun, the feasibility and rationale of disbursement.

In view of the receipt of number of representations from various NGOs regarding non release of installments due to them for their ongoing projects and for projects for which previous installments have already been released, following decisions are being communicated for immediate implementation:


- a) The RR&MCs would take action for the release of the grants in the categories of cases mentioned below, after due verification and scrutiny of all the required documents to be submitted by the NGOs, the monitors' field verification report(s), the audited statements of accounts, utilization certificates and any other document as prescribed in the CAPART policy guidelines and relevant circulars, including the Circular Nos.1/2010, 2/2010 and 7/2010 of CAPART issued with the EC's approval in respect of the committed liabilities of CAPART on account of ongoing projects.
- b) The cases in which releases of funds for 2nd/final installments, or reimbursement of the 10% withheld amounts are due and the cases are placed under the "To Be Continued" (TBC) category as per the Internal Technical Committee (ITC) reports as approved in the 51st EC meeting held on 25.1.2010, provided that the cases are not liable to be placed under funding restrictions on any other ground.

- c) The cases placed under the "Liable To be Terminated" (LTT) category as per the ITC reports, but considered and recommended by the Grievance Redressal Committee (GRC) and approved by the competent for payment of the final installment or reimbursement of the 10% withheld amount.
