
In order to streamline the work pertaining to the Nodal NGO Scheme and to avoid dual processing of project files at CAPART HQ and Regional Committees it has been decided that:

1. The Circular No. 1/2007 bearing file No. 100-3(21)/2005 CD dated 08-02-2007 spelling out the procedure for processing of Nodal NGO projects stand withdrawn.
2. The Nodal NGO as a scheme will be dealt with exclusively at the CAPART-Headquarters and RCs will not have any role to play in the processing of the on going project proposals/files.
3. All the new project proposals will be received and dealt at the CAPART HQ only as per the laid down norms of CAPART and if need be, respective RCs will be consulted to obtain additional information etc. The following decision taken by the Executive Committee, in its meeting held on 15-02-08 will also be kept in mind while processing the project proposals.
 - 3.1 The identification and selection of NGO should be made by CAPART on the basis of their track record, technical and administrative capabilities. However, CAPART may consult, if felt necessary the State Govt. concerned regarding identification of areas and the credential of the VOs.
 - 3.2 Only the backward districts identified by the Planning Commission and the Ministry of Panchayati Raj, Govt of India will be considered by CAPART, under the scheme.
 - 3.3 The pre-funding appraisal of all projects will be mandatory.
 - 3.4 The projects under NNGO scheme should be reviewed after a period of three years.
 - 3.5 Any other issues concerning the location specific needs of the area can also be taken up under the NNGO scheme.

4. CAPART HQ will initiate prompt action and get the projects monitored wherever due, to facilitate timely release of funds etc.

All Officers of CAPART, HQ and RR & MCs, CAPART Regional Committees are requested to note the above instructions for strict compliance.
