CIRCULAR NO. 2 /2008

It is noticed that circular No.18/2006 dated 20th October, 2006 which requires return of incomplete proposals to VOs was being applied for summary rejection of many proposals, thus introducing an element of arbitrariness and ad hocism.

In order, therefore, to promote the mandate of CAPART and to encourage and educate VOs, it has now been decided with the approval of DG that in supersession of the above cited circular, all proposals received from the VOs would be dealt with strictly in accordance with the provision contained in CAPART guidelines(extracts reproduced below).

"The proposal will be examined at desk stage by the division. If the information/documents are not complete, all the queries and outstanding issues pertaining to the proposal will be raised in a consolidated manner to be communicated to the VO through registered post acknowledgement due. The VO will be provided opportunity to submit clarification/documents asked for latest within a period of 45 days. If no response is received from the VO within the said period, the proposal will be liable to be rejected and the file will be closed without any further reference to the VO concerned".
